Press Release by the District Collector.

Applications are invited by the Department of Social Defence from the eligible candidates who possess the following qualifications for appointment of Social Worker Members of the Juvenile Justice Boards constituted under the provisions of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015. Social Worker Member for Juvenile Justice Board is to be appointed on honorarium basis, of which one shall be a woman.

The applicants should have been actively involved in Health, Education or Welfare activities pertaining to children for at least seven years or a practicing professional with a degree in Child Psychology, Psychiatry, Sociology or Law. The age of the applicant should not be less than 35 years and not be more than 65 years. A person shall be eligible for appointment as a Social Worker Member for a maximum of two terms, which shall not be continuous.
