TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR CONTRACT APPOINTMENT

- 3. If the appointee wishes to resign his/her job, he/she has to serve one month's notice or remit one month's salary or pay thereof, as the case may be proportionate to the shortfall in the notice

- 4. The appointee shall perform the duties as assigned to him/her. The Competent Authority reserves the right to assign any duty as and when required. No extra/additional allowances will be admissible in case of such assignment.

Unreserved stands for all applicants including OBC/SC/ST/EWSs. (Only such OBC/SC/ST/EWSs candidates who are selected on the same standard as applied to general candidates shall be treated as own merit candidates. If any OBC/SC/ST/EWSs candidate is selected by getting any relaxation in age, etc., he/she shall be counted against reserved vacancies. Such a candidate cannot be considered for appointment against an unreserved vacancy)

ii) Other Backward Classes (OBC):

Applicants are required to ensure that he/she does not belong to the persons/sections(Creamy Layer) mentioned in Column 3 of the Schedule to the Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training O.M. The disability certificate should be submitted. It should be certified by a duly constituted and authorized medical board of the State or Central Govt. Hospitals/Institutions.

v) Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs):-

Candidates who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs.8.00 lakh (Rupees Eight Lakh Only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application.

Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:-

- i. 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
- ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
- iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
- iv. Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.

The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years. (As per the Office Memorandum F.No.36039/1/2019 dt 31st January 2019 by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances& Pension & F.No.A11013/01/2019 dt. 28th February 2019 by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India)
