Website : www.tnusrb.tn.gov.in <u>Addendum to Information Brochure</u> <u>NOTIFICATION No : 01/2023 AND ITS ADDENDUM THEREOF</u> FOR DIRECT RECRUITMENT TO THE POSTS OF STATION OFFICERS, FIRE & RESCUE SERVICES DEPARTMENT [MEN & WOMEN]-2023

1. Tamil Nadu Uniformed Services Recruitment Board has published a Notification in the dailies on 05.05.2023 for filling up of vacancies in Police Department for the posts of 615 + 6 [Backlog] Sub-Inspectors of Police (Taluk, AR and TSP) through direct recruitment in the year 2023. Subsequently, the board has issued an addendum to the above notification on 23.05.2023 adding the post of 128 + 1 [Backlog] Station Officers (Men & Women) Fire & Rescue Services Department.

2. All the instructions given in the Information Brochure for the direct recruitment of the posts of Sub-Inspectors of Police (Taluk, Armed Reserve and Tamil Nadu Special Police)-2023 will be applicable to the direct recruitment to the posts of Station officers, Fire & Rescue services Department (Men & Women) - 2023 except those that are specifically mentioned hereunder.

3. The Candidate should opt for his/her preference for the department viz. Police or Fire & Rescue Services Department while filling the online application. Once the candidate selects the preference for the department at the time of online application, he/she will not be allowed to change the same at a later date under any circumstances.

5. SCALE OF PAY: Rs. 36,400 – 1,15,700

6. EDUCATIONAL AND OTHER QUALIFICATIONS:

(a) Educational qualification for the recruitment of Station officers, Fire & Rescue services Department is the same as that of the recruitment of Sub-Inspectors of Police (Taluk, AR & TSP)-2023.

(b) Provided that other things being equal, preference shall be given to persons who have successfully undergone any of the training course at National Fire Service College, Nagpur.

Note: There are no Sports quota and Wards quota for the recruitment of the posts of Station Officers.

8. TRANSGENDER:

The Transgender candidates are not eligible to apply for the direct recruitment to the posts of Station Officers (Men & Women), Fire & Rescue Services- 2023.

9. ELIGIBILITY FOR 20% FIRE & RESCUE SERVICES DEPARTMENTAL QUOTA CANDIDATES:

- Firemen, Leading Firemen, Firemen Driver and Driver Mechanic in the Fire & Rescue Services Department can apply under 20% Departmental Quota if they meet the following eligibility criteria as per the GO. Ms. No.234 Home (Pol-XVII) Dept. Dt: 13.05.2023.
 - a) They should have completed 5 years of service as on the date of notification.
 - b) They should have a clean record without any punishment other than the minor punishment of censure in their entire service.
 - c) Provided that other things being equal, preference shall be given to persons who have successfully undergone any of the training course at National Fire Service College, Nagpur.
 - d) The departmental candidates should obtain an NOC in the prescribed format from the Head of Unit / Office / competent authority and it should be uploaded while applying online. (Specimen NOC is available in <u>Annexure. VII-A</u>).

- ii. Main Written Examination for departmental quota will be held separately. A departmental candidate may apply for both open and departmental quota, if he satisfies the eligibility criteria.
- iii. In case required number of candidates are not available in the Departmental Quota, the vacancies would be transferred to open quota of the same community.
- iv. Communal reservation is followed within Departmental quota as per existing rules.

10. STAGES OF RECRUITMENT FOR 20% DEPARTMENTAL CANDIDATES: WRITTEN EXAMINATION:

Part I. TAMIL LANGUAGE ELIGIBILITY TEST:

The Tamil Language Eligibility Test will be conducted commonly for Open and Departmental candidates.

Part II. MAIN WRITTEN EXAMINATION FOR 20% DEPARTMENTAL QUOTA:

Main written examination consists of Part-A - General Knowledge and Part-B – Psychology Test: Communication skills, Numerical analysis, Mental Ability, Logical Analysis and Information handling ability. Rules and Regulations relating to Fire and Rescue Services, Station Routine, Tamil Nadu Fire Service Manual and Administration of Fire and Rescue Services. Written examination total marks are 85.

(Note – Directions for using the 'Test Dot Card')

- (1) Place the recruit with his back to the light and hold the test card perfectly upright in front of him at a measured distance of exactly 100 feet. The light should fall fully on the card.
- (2) Examine each eye separately. The eye not under trial should be shaded by the hand of an Assistant who will take care not to press on the eye ball.
- (3) Expose some of the 'dots' not more than seven or eight at a time and desire the recruit make their number and position. Vary the groups frequently to provide against deception.
